

Fate Jones

Fate (Casey) Jones, 77, Center, died at his home at 1:07 a.m. Tuesday following a seven years' illness.

Born in Hawkins County, Tenn., Jan. 2, 1889, he was the son of James and Dosie (Parker) Jones. He had resided in the Kokomo area since 1916.

In 1907 he was married to Ida Belle Brown, who preceded him in death in 1920. Then in 1928 he was married to Nellie Gordon, who survives.

He was a retired 24-year employe of the Continental Steel Corp. He had been employed there in the open-hearth electrical department, and was a member of the CIO-AFL Local Steelworkers Union 1054.

Surviving in addition to the widow are a daughter, Mrs. Joseph (Verna) Wooldridge and a son, Earl Jones, both of Kokomo, and another son, Jack L. Jones, Orem, Utah; nine grandchildren; 41 great-grandchildren; five great-great grandchildren and several nieces and nephews. A daughter, a brother and a sister are deceased.

Funeral services will be conducted in the Ellers Funeral Chapel at 2 p.m. Thursday. Burial will be in the Albright Cemetery.
