

John M. Kelsay

John M. Kelsay, 79 years old, Kokomo R. R. 6, father of Howard County Councilman Montell Kelsay, died at 11 p. m. Saturday at Tipton County Hospital, following a short illness.

He was born July 22, 1883, on a farm near Hemlock, the son of Joshua and Mary (Fenn) Kelsay. He spent all of his life in Howard Tipton Counties as a farmer.

He was formerly married to Mae Gasho, and she died in 1910. In 1930, he married Nora Hollingsworth, who died in 1939.

Surviving are the son, Montell, who lives near Hemlock; two granddaughters, four great-grandchildren; one sister, Mrs. Harry (Edna) Harness, of Phoenix, Ariz. One sister preceded him in death.
