David W. Lee, 90, 929 N. Main St., died at 5:30 p.m. Tuesday in his home. He had been seriously ill for the past month.

The son of A. J. and Martha Turner Lee, he was born Nov. 27, 1871, in Hamilton County, Ill. He had farmed and worked timber most of his life, spending the past 19 years in Kokomo.
