

Mrs. Ada D. Little Dies in Hospital

Mrs. Ada Della Little, 74, 1305 S. Ohio Ave., died at 12:30 p.m. Tuesday in St. Joseph's Memorial Hospital, following a lingering illness.

Born Oct. 3, 1889 in Tipton County, she was the daughter of William and Elizabeth Wooldridge. In 1905 she was married to James M. Little, who died in 1944. She had spent practically her entire life in this vicinity.

Mrs. Little was a member of the Kokomo Gospel Tabernacle.
