Edward A. Lucas, 74, Kokomo R. R. 6, died at 10:10 a.m. Tuesday in Howard Community Hospital, after an illness of six months. He was a retired farmer.

Born near Delphi on June 10, 1891, the son of Parker and Anna (Stokes) Lucas, and had lived in Kokomo approximately 50 years. Mr. Lucas was married in 1912 to Mabel McReynolds, and she died in 1951. In 1956 he was married to Alma Hubbard, and she survives.
