Clifford D. Maish, 56, 1000 Alto Road E., was dead on arrival in the emergency room at St. Joseph Memorial Hospital shortly before noon Thursday. He apparently suffered a heart attack.

Born July 12, 1921, in Howard County, he was the son of Enoch and Reta (Stout) Maish. He was married in 1944 to Margaret Davis, who survives.

He retired Aug. 31, 1977, from Delco Electronics Division where he had been a general foreman.
