

## Shelbert A. Shumaker

Shelbert A. Shumaker, 63, 2001 S. Bell St., died unexpectedly at 6:18 p.m. Monday in St. Joseph's Hospital, shortly after admittance.

Mr. Shumaker had been employed at the Delco Radio Corporation as a tool and die maker since 1938.

Born April 21, 1899, in Somerset Co., Pa., he was the son of Jonas and Emma (Humbert) Shumaker and had lived in Kokomo most of his adult life.

In 1924 he married Miss Azalea Jackson, who survives.

Surviving with his wife are two sons: Glenn of Kokomo and Warren of White Sands, N.
