GREENTOWN—Ross T. Smith, 68, Greentown R. R. 1, died at 2 p.m. Tuesday in Howard Community Hospital. Although he had been in ill health for some time, death was unexpected from a heart attack.

Born in Taylor Township, March 16, 1894, he was the son of William S. and Mary (Toby) Smith.

His marriage was to Esther W. Shenk on March 12, 1919, and she died Sept. 21, 1956.

Mr. Smith was a member of the Macedonia Christian Church and past master of the Naphtali Lodge, No. 389, F and AM.
