

## THURSTON SERVICES

Funeral services for Fred L. Thurston, 62, 816 S. Home Ave., who died Thursday afternoon of a heart attack while driving a truck, will be at 2 p.m. Sunday in the Ellers Funeral Chapel, with the Rev.
