

## Herbert Lauderbaugh

**ANDERSON** — Herbert Harold Lauderbaugh, 85, died Tuesday, Sept. 5, 2000, at St. John's Medical Center following a brief illness. Born July 3, 1915, in West Virginia, he was the son of John Harold and Florence Lauderbaugh. He was married to Ruth Lauderbaugh, who died in 1958. He later married Lavon Cade Lauderbaugh, who survives. She was his wife of 37 years.
