Mamie Bryant Stevenson Solomon, 90, Kokomo, died 4:45 p.m. Friday, Sept. 16, 2005, at St. Joseph Hospital. She was born July 18, 1915, in Todd County, Ky., the daughter of George and Ruby (Fox) Bryant. Both preceded her in death.
