

Mary C. Hadley, New London, Dies

New London, Ind., Jan. 1—(Tribune Area Special)—Mrs. Mary Cosand Hadley, 79, died Tuesday morning at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Florence Mills of West Hartford, Conn., where she had gone to attend the wedding of her granddaughter and spend Christmas. She suffered a stroke Sunday morning and did not regain consciousness.

Her husband, Jonathan Hadley, preceded her in death several years ago.

Surviving are three children: Russell Hadley of Michigan; Florence Mills of West Hartford, Conn., and Mrs. Carrie Mae Gilbert of Ft. Wayne; three sisters, Mrs. Ada Brown of New London, Mrs. Violet Kenworthy of Fairmount and Mrs. Norah Cosand of New London, and one brother, Charles E. Cosand of Richmond.

Mrs. Hadley was the daughter of Nathan and Priscilla Cosand, pioneer family of New London and all the Cosand children were born in New London.

The deceased was a member of the second graduating class of New London high school. She was a

member of the missionary board of Western Yearly Meeting of Friends and was prominent in the work of the church.

The body will be accompanied here from the east by the son-in-law and it is expected that services will be held Thursday afternoon in New London Friends church.
