

ARTHUR HANSON DIES AT KOKOMO HOSPITAL

Funeral services were held Wednesday afternoon at the New London Friends church for Arthur Hanson, 85, lifelong resident of New London, who died at the St. Joseph hospital in Kokomo at 12:50 a.m. Sunday.

Mr. Hanson had been ill for the last three years and in the hospital a week. Thrombosis was given as the immediate cause of death.

The deceased was the son of Thomas and Mary (Williams) Hanson and was born March 22, 1868. He married Clara Morris March 21, 1891. She died July 14, 1941.

Surviving is an only son, Vincent L. Hanson who with his wife lived with the deceased at his home in New London. There are two grandchildren, and several nieces and nephews.

Mr. Hanson was a birthright member of the New London Friends Church in which he was active in Sunday School and as a choir leader. He was also active in the Wildcat Glee Club and sang in other quartets.
