

JONATHAN HARRELL

Departs This Life at the Advanced
Age of Seventy-nine Years.

Jonathan Harrell died Sunday morning at 10:30 o'clock at the home of his son-in-law, Frank DeLon, 77 West Monroe street, of paralysis, aged seventy-nine years. The funeral was held today at 12 o'clock at the Wildcat Christian church, conducted by the pastor, Rev. J. I. Mouncey. The remains were buried at New London.

Mr. Harrell was one of the pioneer residents of Ervin township, having lived in that section of the county for many years. His wife preceded him to the grave about five years ago, since which time he has made his home with Frank DeLon, his son-in-law. All his children have been called to the great beyond. He is survived by two granddaughters, daughters of Mr. Frank DeLon.
