

## REV. HARTSUCK, RETIRED FRIENDS MINISTER, DIES

New London, Ind., Oct. 22—(Tribune Special)—The Rev. J. E. Hartsuck, 68, who has served as pastor in the Friends church in Oklahoma, Iowa, Ohio, and Wabash, Ind., died Friday afternoon at his home in New London. About three years ago he retired from the active ministry and moved with his wife to New London. *L. 10-22-1937*
