

# MRS. HEATON IS DEAD

WIFE OF FRANK HEATON SUC-  
CUMBS AT HOME NEAR  
RUSSIAVILLE.

Russiaville, March 3 1937 (Tribune Special)—Mrs. Alice Heaton, 58, wife of Frank Heaton, died at her home, near Russiaville, at 4:30 a. m. Wednesday. She had been ill several months with complications.

Born April 22, 1878 in Clinton county, she was one of seven children of John and Phoebe Conrad. Mr. and Mrs. Heaton were married August 29, 1897, and four children were born to this union. Since her marriage, Mrs. Heaton has resided in the Russiaville community, excepting 16 years, which the family lived in Wabash county.

Surviving are the husband, one son, Herman, near Russiaville, two daughters, Mrs. Ural Wyrick of Kokomo and Mrs. Clarence Cain of Wabash county, one brother, Edgar Conrad of Bluffton, Md., three sisters, Mrs. Sadie Britton of Spencer, Ind., Mrs. Etta Ratcliff of Ossian, Ind., and Mrs. Tivia Lane of Milwaukee, Wis., and four grandchildren. An infant son, Herbert, preceded his mother in death in 1916.

Mrs. Heaton was a member of the Santa Fe Wesleyan Methodist church. Funeral services will be held at the New London Friends church Friday afternoon at 2 o'clock. The Rev. Herbert Drake, pastor of the Santa Fe Wesleyan Methodist church, will be in charge. He will be assisted by the Rev. E. Howard Brown of the Reserve Friends church. Burial will be in the New London cemetery.
