RUSSIAVILLE — Paul W. Kenworthy, 56, died at 1:20 a.m. Monday at his home in New London. He had been in ill health for three days.

Born Jan. 12, 1903, in western Howard County, he was the son of Earl and Lucretia (Thompson) Kenworthy and spent his entire life in the New London community.

Mr. Kenworthy was graduated from the New London High School and was a birthright member of the New London Friends Church. He was engaged in farming most of his life and for the last three years had been employed by the Western High School.

On Sept. 19, 1923, he was married to Nina Mae Gordon, who survives. Also surviving are his mother, three children, James of Kokomo, Mrs. Alberta Steiner of West Middleton and Mrs. Jeanne Walker of Russiaville; a sister, Mrs. Catherine Wyant of Kokomo R.R.; a brother, Clarence Kenworthy of Kokomo R.R. 6, and eight grandchildren. His father and a sister preceded him in death.

Funeral services will be at 2 p.m. Wednesday at the New London Friends Church, with the Rev. Allan Reynolds of Indianapolis officiating. The body will lie in state at the church one hour preceding services. Burial will be in the New London Cemetery.
