NEW LONDON — Funeral services for Mrs. Louie Kenworthy Kantzer, 89, New London, will be at 2 p.m. Thursday in the Stout Funeral Home at Russiaville with the Rev. Robert Beck officiating. Burial will be in the New London Cemetery.

Mrs. Kantzer died at 8:20 a.m. Tuesday in the Clinton County Hospital, Frankfort. She had been in failing health for the last four years.

Born Oct. 12, 1877 in Miami County, she was the daughter of John T. and Catherine (Maple) Thompson. On Sept. 1, 1898, she was married to Earl T. Kenworthy, and he died in 1936. Her second marriage was to George Kantzer of Mexico, Ind., July 20, 1940, and he preceded her in death.

Mrs. Kantzer had lived practically all her life in the New London vicinity. She was a member of New London Friends Church and of its W.C.T.U.
