

## Verlin Kenworthy

Verlin Kenworthy, 90, New London, died in his home at 5:30 p.m. Monday. He had been in failing health for one year.

A retired farmer, he had spent his entire lifetime in the New London area and was a member of a pioneer family of that community. He was a member of the New London Friends Church.

Born in New London, Nov. 18, 1881, he was the son of Thomas and Elizabeth (Small) Kenworthy.

On Aug. 26, 1903, he was married to Ethel Hubbard, who preceded him in death on Jan. 14, 1944. Then, on Dec. 2, 1954, he was united in marriage with Ophia Watson, who survives with a son, Clarkson of Greenfield, Ohio; a daughter, Miss Alice Kenworthy, Indianapolis; a sister, Mrs. John (Alma) Littler, Kokomo; a brother, Elbert Kenworthy, Kokomo; two grandchildren; five step-grandchildren; four great-grandchildren and four step-great-grandchildren. Funeral services will be at 2 p.m. Thursday in the New London Meetinghouse with the Rev. Robert Beck officiating. Burial will be in the New London Cemetery.
