

## Mrs. John Kile, New London, Dies

Mrs. Anna Rose Kile, 75, wife of John E. Kile, died at 2 o'clock Saturday afternoon at New London of a cerebral hemorrhage, after an illness of nine weeks.

She was the daughter of George and Sarah Kanable Dunlap. She was born March 1, 1873, in Howard county and lived all but seven years in Howard county. She was a member of the Cloverdale Methodist church and was active in the W. S. C. S.

The body was removed to the Thomas funeral home in Galveston, where friends may call until noon Tuesday. It will then be taken to Cloverdale church where it will lie in state from 1 to 2 o'clock and where funeral services will be held at 2 o'clock, with the Rev. Paul Simmons officiating. Burial will follow in New London cemetery.
