John Edward Kile, 76, long-time resident of the New London vicinity, died at 8:15 o'clock Friday morning at the home of his daughter, Mrs. Bessie Taylor, at New London. He had been ill the last 10 months with a complication of diseases.

The deceased was born June 4, 1874, in Dacatur county, the son Kyle.

He had been a member of the Methodist faith since youth, being affiliated with the Cloverdale church near New London where he was always active in service and where he had been a trustee.

The body was taken to the Thomas funeral home in Galveston where friends may call from 2 o'clock Saturday afternoon until noon Sunday. It will then be taken to Cloverdale Methodist church to lie in state until services at 2 o'clock that afternoon. Interment will be in the New London cemetery.
