MRS. ETTIS KIRKENDALL

Russiaville, April 26—Mrs. Edna Kirkendall, 73, wife of Ettis Kirkendall, died at 2:30 o'clock Thursday morning at the family home in Russiaville of a heart attack.

She was born in Kansas, September 8, 1878, the daughter of Henry and Martha Moulder. She and Mr. Kirkendall were married February 13, 1898, and all the 55 years of their married life had been spent in this community.

Mrs. Kirkendall was a member of the Russiaville Eastern Star lodge and the Methodist church.
