MRS. ARCHIE LEAP.

Mrs. Vera Leap, 59, wife of Archie Leap, Russiaville route 2, died at 10 o'clock Sunday night at St. Vincent's hospital, in Indianapolis, where she had been a patient the last month. Death resulted from cancer.

Mrs. Leap was the daughter of John and Della Moulder Talbert and was born February 14, 1890. All her life had been spent in the Russiaville vicinity. She and Mr. Leap were married October 18, 1912.

Surviving with the husband are her mother, one brother, Luther Talbert of Russiaville, and seven nieces and nephews. Two sisters and a brother, Mrs. Marie Orem and Roxy and Harry Talbert, preceded her in death.

After the death of Mrs. Orem, Mrs. Leap sought to take the place of a mother to her two children, Lex and Max Orem.

The deceased was a birthright member of the Lynn Friends church, a member of the Friends Missionary Society Working Band, the W. C. T. U., and the Honey Creek Township Home Economics club, giving active service to all organizations with which she was affiliated.

Funeral arrangements have not been completed but services will be sometime Wednesday. The body will be taken to the home of her mother, Mrs. Della Talbert, in Russiaville Tuesday morning. *Surv. NL*
