

AGED LADY DIES AT RUSSIAVILLE

Mrs. Caroline Lee, 82. Is
Dead After Illness of
Ten Days

RUSSIAVILLE, Ind., Dec. 21—
Mrs. Caroline Lee, age eighty-two,
northwest of Russiaville, died at
11:30 Friday night, of a complica-
tion of ailments. She had been ill
ten days and died at the home of
her son, Manford Lee.

Since the death of her husband
two years ago, Mrs. Lee had lived

with her children. For a number
of years before that she had re-
sided in Greentown.

Mrs. Lee was a daughter of
Moses and Tamer Spray and was
born in Wayne county. Four chil-
dren survive, two sons and two
daughters. The sons are Pearlbe
and Manford Lee of Russiaville.
The daughters are Mrs. John Davis
of Russiaville and Mrs. Marlon
Kimmel of Greentown.

The funeral will take place Mon-
day at one o'clock, at the Friends
church, the Rev. Thomas Newlon
officiating. Burial will be in New
London cemetery.

The body is at the home of the
daughter, Mrs. John Davis, Rus-
siville.
