

## George F. Lindley, Russiaville, Dies

Russiaville, Ind., Ind., March 23—  
(Tribune Area Special)—George F. Lindley, 71, died at 1:30 o'clock Friday afternoon at his home east of Russiaville. He had been in failing health for several months with a heart ailment and complications. He was bedfast three weeks.

Mr. Lindley was the son of John T. and Rachael (Mills) Lindley and lived his entire life on the farm on which he was born. He was a lifetime member of the Lynn Friends church near his home and was active in the church as long as his health permitted.
