

## Herman Lindley,

### Russiaville, Dies; *apr. 25, 1967* Funeral Thursday

RUSSEVILLE — Herman Lindley, 62, Russiaville R. R. 1, died Tuesday at 5:30 a.m. in the Robert Long Hospital at Indianapolis following a three-week illness.

Born in western Howard County, May 12, 1904, he was the son of Thomas and Arvilla (Carter) Lindley. He had lived in the Russiaville area his entire lifetime.
