Clyde Lindley, 72, Russiaville R.R. 1, died at 10:15 a.m. Monday in his home of an apparent heart attack.

Born April 10, 1902, in Prairie Township, Tipton County, he was the son of Fred T. and Florence (Heaton) Lindley. He was married April 20, 1924, to Mary Catherine Oilar, who survives.
