

LYBROOK—On the 28th of July, 1880, at his residence, two-and-a-half miles southeast of Rustaville, William B. Lybrook, in the 58th year of his age.

Mr. Lybrook was born in Giles county, Virginia, July 29, 1823. Removed with his parents to the farm on which he lived at the time of his death in 1848. Was married in 1854 to Rachel Williams, who with four children survives him. He has always been a highly esteemed and honored citizen, very industrious, and honest in all his dealings with his fellow-men, and a kind and affectionate husband and father. He has always taken a deep interest in the subject of education, taking great care that his children should have a thorough education, the eldest of which, Phillip Lybrook, is one of Howard county's best teachers. He has been for about twelve years a consistent member of the Friends' church, and although his sickness was of only a few hours duration, he gave evidence to his sorrowing family that he "was going home to rest." The bereaved family have the sympathy of the entire community.

The funeral occurred on Sunday, the 29th, at 3 o'clock p. m. Services were conducted by James Newlin and others. Interment in the New London
