

HELEN NEWBY DIES

Miss Helen Fernetta Newby, age 30, died at 10:00 o'clock Friday morning at the home of her parents, Mr. and Mrs. Merrill Newby, one-half mile northeast of New London. Complications resulted in her death which followed a long illness, a year of which she was bedfast.

Miss Newby was born April 3, 1909, on the Kenworthy farm in Monroe township and a few years later she and her parents moved to the farm where the family now resides. She was the only graduate in the class of 1928 of New London high school and while in school took a prominent part in all school activities. Miss Newby was a member of the New London Friends church while in school and later when employed in Medaryville attended the Christian church.

Surviving with the parents are three brothers, Leonard of Kokomo, Loren of West Middleton and Lester at home; one sister, Ermal Jane, and a grandfather, Thomas Long, also at home.

Funeral services will be held at the New London Friends church Sunday afternoon at 2:30 o'clock with the Rev. Allen Reynolds officiating and burial will be in the cemetery near the church. The body will be taken from the Long funeral home to the home of the parents Friday evening and friends may call there after 7:00 p. m.
