

Glenn H. Newby, former Russiaville postmaster dead

Glenn H. Newby, 70, Russiaville, died at 11:30 a.m. Monday in the Indiana State Soldiers Home, Lafayette. He had been in failing health for several years. 10-6-75

Born Nov. 1, 1895 in Monroe Township, he was the son of William R. and Merab (Shirley) Newby. He was married Feb. 19, 1918, to Ethel Hamilton, who died Feb. 24, 1967.

A career serviceman, he served in the U.S. Army during World War I and World War II. He was Russiaville postmaster for several years and had been deputy Howard County clerk, deputy Howard County sheriff and had operated an insurance business for several years.

He was a member of New London Friends Church and the Lions Club, Masonic Lodge, Order of the Eastern Star and American Legion in Russiaville.

Surviving are two daughters, Mrs. Ralph (Betty) Walker of Kokomo and Mrs. Orren (Barbara) Dutton of Kenosha, Wis.; a brother, Kenneth Newby of Russiaville; and two grandchildren. Two brothers and two sisters preceded him in death.
