

LUELLA NEWBY DIES

MONROE TWP. WOMAN SUC-
CUMBS AFTER LONG ILLNESS
OF HEART TROUBLE.

Mrs. Luella Newby, age 81, widow of the late Joshua Newby, died at 10:30 o'clock Monday night at her home in Monroe township following an illness of heart trouble from which she had suffered for nearly five years.
