MRS. PEARL M. NEWLIN

Russiaville, May 4—(Tribune Area Special)—Mrs. Pearl Merrell Newlin, 71, died suddenly at 7 o'clock Wednesday night at her home west of New London. She was in apparent good health until stricken.
