

MRS. FLORENCE NEWLIN.

Mrs. Florence Newlin, 83, widow of Dr. W. H. Newlin and member of a pioneer family of the New London community, died about 11 o'clock Thursday morning at her home in New London. She had been in falling health for some time and Tuesday night suffered a stroke.

All her life had been spent in New London where she was born, the daughter of Clarkson and Sophronia Reese Haworth. She was educated in the New London schools and taught there one year. In 1889 she married Dr. Newlin. He died in 1935.

Surviving are three children, Miss Lolo Newlin, who was a teacher in the Whiting schools until she resigned to take care of her mother, Eugene Newlin of New London, and Eva, wife of George Ehrman of Clay township. A son Horace died in 1936 and Roy in 1938. All three of her sons served in World War I.

She leaves also a sister and five brothers, Miss Hattie Haworth of New London, C. V. Haworth of Kokomo, Morris P. and Glen Haworth of New London, Reese Haworth of Pomona, Calif., and James Haworth of Toledo, O.

She was a member of the New London Friends church and of the Eastern Star lodge there.

Funeral services will be held at 2 o'clock Saturday afternoon at the New London Friends church with the Rev. Valentine Krumm officiating. Burial will be in the New London cemetery.
