

THOMAS E. NEWLIN

Funeral services for Thomas E. Newlin, former Howard County resident who died at age 90 in Amery, Wis., Saturday, will be held at 2 p.m. today in the Russiaville Friends Church, instead of in the New London Friends Church as previously planned.

In charge of services will be the Rev. Herbert Pettengill, who will be assisted by the Rev. Francis Brown.

THOMAS E. NEWLIN, 90, a beloved minister of Russiaville Monthly Meeting and New London Quarterly Meeting, died in the hospital at Amery, Wisconsin February 7. Funeral services were held at Russiaville Friends Church with Herbert Pettingill, pastor, in charge. Several fellow ministers were present.

He was early a member of New London Meeting. Moving to Russiaville where he was in the hardware business, he became a member of that Meeting. Later he was pastor of the Bethel Meeting. All these Meetings profited much from his able ministry.

Thomas Newlin had lived with his daughter in Wisconsin for the last five years. Besides the daughter, Mrs. Earl Spink, a son, Russell, of Kansas, and several grandchildren and great-grandchildren survive.
