

Linus Nicholson

CAYUGA, Ind. — Linus D. Nicholson, 85, a resident of Cayuga for 40 years, died at 3:45 p.m. Wednesday, Sept. 19, 1984, in Vermillion Manor Nursing Home in Tilton, Ill.

Born in Marion County, Feb. 3, 1899, he was the son of Marcus D. and Emma (Jackson) Nicholson. Dec. 20, 1919, he married Anna Pearl Wright, who died July 12, 1981.
