

Aug. LYDIA A. PEACOCK 1942

Lydia A. Peacock, daughter of Joseph and Caroline Jopps Peacock, deceased, died about 7:30 o'clock Monday night at her home, 2116 South Webster street, after an illness that became acute about two weeks ago.

Miss Peacock was born near Fairmount but spent her childhood days in the New London neighborhood. She was graduated from the New London high school, attended Indiana State Normal school at Terre Haute and taught in the schools of Monroe and Honey Creek townships and Kokomo.

The family moved to Kokomo and Miss Peacock became a clerk in the William H. Turner store, where she continued over a long period. She was a member of the Union Street Friends church.

Surviving are one sister, Ruth E. Peacock of Kokomo; a brother, William J. Peacock of St. Louis, Mo., and several nieces and nephews. A sister, Adaline, long a teacher in the Kokomo schools, passed away April 15 of this year.
