RUSSEVILLE, Ind. — Earl Quinn Jr., 66, died at 11:05 p.m. Friday, March 23, 1990, in his home on Russiaville R.R. 1.

He was born Feb. 18, 1924, in Howard County to Earl and Ollilia (Thompson) Quinn. A 1943 graduate of Kokomo High School, he had lived in the Russiaville area for 38 years.



On Oct. 2, 1947, he married Grace C. Quinn Fivecoate, who survives.

Also surviving are two sons, Tom Quinn of Russiaville and Tim Quinn of Kokomo; a foster son, Jack Fivecoate of Russiaville; a daughter, Mrs. Jerry (Susan) Badgett of Russiaville; and 11 grandchildren.

Quinn, a machinist, retired from Continental Steel Corp. after working there 33 years. He had been a Delco Electronics Corp. employee for 11 years. He was a member of New London Friends Church, United Steelworkers Local 1052, United Auto Workers Local 292, the Experimental Aircraft Association and the Worldwide BMW Motorcycle Club. He served in the Navy during World War II.
