

WILLIAM D. REED DIES

FORMER HOWARD COUNTY
MAN EXPIRES IN MARION;
SON IN KOKORO

William P. Reed, 79, former Howard county resident, died at his home, 3002 1/2 South Ray street, Marion, at 7:45 o'clock Friday evening, following an illness of about two years.

Mr. Reed, a lifelong farmer, was born in Harrison township, Howard county, and lived there until six years ago when he moved to Green township, Grant county. One year ago in March he retired from active farm life and moved to Marion, where he had since resided.

Surviving are the widow, Lily; three sons, Austin Reed of Michigantown, Ross Reed of Pontiac, Mich., and Frank Reed of Kalamazoo; four daughters, Miss Mildred Reed of Marion, Mrs. Florence Muggan of Crosswell, Mich., Mrs. Mary Lanes of Bakersfield, Calif., and Miss Ethel Reed of Marion; one sister, Mrs. Ella Sikes living near Russiaville and a half brother, Robert Moore, near West Middleton.
