

Mrs. Mary Reiber Dies at Home Here

Mrs. Mary Evaline Reiber, 35, wife of Henry B. Reiber, died at 6:45 o'clock Monday morning at her home, 928 South Webster street. Death resulted from an illness of complications of several months' duration.

Mrs. Reiber was born March 23, 1856, in Miami county, Ohio, the daughter of Frederick and Debra Hoover. The family moved to this state, locating near New London, in 1880. Her marriage to Mr. Reiber took place June 18, 1880.

One child was born to them, a daughter who now lives in South Bend. Besides the husband and daughter, she is survived by two grandchildren, four great-grandchildren, one brother, Jacob Hoover of Pasadena, Calif., and two sisters, Mrs. Edna Carpenter of Pasadena and Mrs. Thomas Newlin of New London.

The deceased was a member of the Pilgrim Holiness church of this city, and the funeral will be held at the church at 10 o'clock Wednesday morning with the Rev. E. J. Clem in charge, assisted by the Rev. Carl R. Road. Burial will be in the New London cemetery.

The body will be removed from the Wayne Ladd funeral home to the residence at 1 o'clock Tuesday afternoon, when friends may call at any time.
