CLOVERDALE, Ind. — Wayne Rhine, 55, Cloverdale, died at 11:45 p.m. Saturday, Nov. 23, 1991 in University Hospital in Indianapolis.

He was born Oct. 6, 1936, in Burlington, a son of Cecil S. and Kathryn E. (Spann) Rhine. March 17, 1957, he married Hattie McCoy who survives.

Rhine also had lived in Burlington, Lafayette, Crawfordsville and Harmony. He owned Rhines Market here. He had owned a grocery store in Burlington and was an employee of Kroger Co. for 18 years. He was a 1954 graduate of Burlington High School. The Rhines were foster parents for 20 years in Marion County.

He was a member of Cloverlode Masonic Lodge 132, Order of Eastern Star, York Rite at Crawfordsville, Scottish Rite Valley of Indianapolis and Murat Temple. He was president of Murat Clowns and active in Hillbilly Club, Railroad Club and Royal Order of Jesters.

Also surviving are four sons, Rick Rhine of Greencastle, Randy and Rusty Rhine, both of Cloverdale, and Rod Rhine of Santa Maria, Calif.; two daughters, Retha Hunsicker of Dayton and Renita Rhine of Cloverdale; his mother of Burlington; a brother, Dr. Sam Rhine of Fishers; a sister, Janice Revolt of Dunkirk; and nine grandchildren.
