

EBBIE PRESTON RICHARDSON

Funeral services for Ebbie Preston Richardson, 79, will be held at 2 o'clock Tuesday afternoon in the chapel at the Rich funeral home. Burial will be in the New London cemetery. Friends may call at the funeral home after 4 o'clock Monday afternoon. Mr. Richardson died at 4 o'clock Saturday afternoon after an illness of four years duration. *July 26 - 1947*

He was born at Louisburg, Kas., but the greater part of his life had been spent at West Middleton. He was a son of John Henry and Mary Heaton Richardson, pioneers of Howard and Clinton counties, and a grandson of Col. Daniel Heaton, veteran of the War of 1812 and the Mexican war and of Capt. Richardson who fought in the war of 1812.

Surviving are one sister, Mrs. Linnie Bell Howard of Los Angeles, Calif., and one brother, John Richardson of Palermo, Calif., with many nieces and nephews and cousins in Indiana and California.

The deceased was a carpenter by trade and a member of the Carpenters union and the I. O. O. F. lodge. He was a quiet, unassuming man and since early youth had been a student of nature.
