

# Robert Rich

BRADENTON, Fla. — Robert E. Rich, 65, Bradenton, Fla., died at 9 p.m. Saturday Dec. 7, 1985, in Blake Memorial Hospital here.

He was born Aug. 19, 1920, in Yeddo, Ind., a son of James and Nellie (Hicks) Rich. Oct. 16, 1942, he married Martha Fisher, who survives.

Also surviving are a daughter, Mrs. Gary (Sarah) Wheeler of West Salem, Wis.; a sister, Mrs. Richard Allen of St. Bernice, Ind.; and two grandchildren. Three brothers are deceased.

A veteran of World War II, he served from 1942 to 1946. He had lived in Indianapolis, Attica and Danville, Ind., areas before moving here after retiring in 1978.
