## FUNERAL OF CLARA BELLE ROTH TO BE HELD AT NEW LONDON

New London, Ind., July 12—Mrs. Clara Belle Roth, 59, wife of Sylvester Roth, died about noon Friday at her home in New London.

Mrs. Roth was the daughter of William M. and Emily Freeman and was born May 31, 1876, in Monroe county. She grew to womanhood in that county and was married to Howard Middleton, August 20, 1896. One child, Lucile, was born to them. The husband died January 9, 1902.

Her second marriage took place February 8, 1905, to Sylvester Roth, who survives with three children, Mary and Minerva, twins, and Ida Roth. A son died in infancy.

Mrs. Roth was a member of the Russiaville Baptist church for many years and was devoted to her church, family and friends. She was a member of the Eastern Star chapter at New London.

The deceased lived in New London for fifteen years and had charge of the telephone exchange there practically all of that time.

Funeral services will be held at 2 o'clock Sunday afternoon at the Friends church in New London.
