

## J. J. SMALL IS DEAD

Following a long period of gradually failing health due to diseases incident to age, J. J. Small, eighty-six, died at 7 o'clock Monday morning at his home, 1724 South Washington street. *Aug. 29, 1932.*

... is survived by the widow, Myra Stout Small, to whom he was married sixty-two years ago, one son, Dan E. Small of this city and two grandchildren. He leaves also a half-brother and half-sister, Milton Small of New London and Miss Jennie Small of Terre Haute.

Mr. Small had spent the greater part of his life in Howard county living, most of the time, in the vicinity of New London and Russiaville. He was born at Richmond, Ind., October 25, 1846, the son of Gideon and Dinah Jane Small. Soon after his marriage he moved to this county where he has since resided, the last three years in Kokomo.

He was a member of the Friends church being affiliated with the church at Russiaville where the funeral will be held at 10 o'clock Wednesday morning, to be followed by burial at the New London cemetery.
