

**MRS. MIRA SMALL EXPIRES
LESS THAN ONE MONTH
AFTER MATE.**

Mrs. Mira Small, age eighty-six, died Thursday morning at 5:45 o'clock at her home, 1724 South Washington street. She had been gradually failing in health since the death of her husband, J. J. Small, on last August 29.

Surviving are one son, Dan E. Small and two granddaughters, Mrs. Marie S. Hadley and Mrs. Gladys Boyer, all of this city. She leaves also two brothers, Charles K. Stout of Hamilton, Ga., and the Rev. Lewis E. Stout of Plainfield, Ind.

Mrs. Small was born in Orange county, the daughter of Sias and Martha Stout. She was a small child when her parents moved to the New London neighborhood and in that vicinity the remainder of her useful life was largely spent. There she and Mr. Small were married on November 18, 1868. Several years ago they came to Kokomo to make their home.

She was a member of the Friends faith, holding membership in the Courtland Avenue church where funeral will be held Saturday morning at 10 o'clock. Burial will be in the cemetery at New London.
