E. M. Small, Monroe Township, Expires

E. M. Small, prominent Monroe township farmer, died Monday morning at the home of his daughter, Mrs. Russell Taylor, who resides one mile north of New London. Although Mr. Small's health had been failing for several months, the serious illness preceding his death was only a few days' duration.

Mr. Small, who was a member of the New London Friends church and had been active in its affairs for a great many years, had just reached his 74th birthday on July 22.

He is survived by his sister, Miss Jennie Small of New London; two daughters, Mrs. Russell Taylor of New London and Mrs. Clarence Kenworthy of West Middleton; a son, Marion C. Small of Mount Morris, Ill., and eight grandchildren.

Funeral services will be held Wednesday at 2 p. m. in the Friends church at New London. The body will lie in state at the church for one hour prior to the funeral. After that time the casket will be closed and will not be re-opened.
