

**JESSE SNODGRASS.** 1917

Russiaville, Sept. 7—(Tribune Area Special)—Jesse "Doc" Snodgrass, 63, died at 10:30 o'clock Sunday night at his home here of complications that followed the flu. He had been ill a month.

The deceased was born in Clinton county December 11, 1883, the son of James and Sarah Snodgrass. He was married March 25, 1903, to Vivian Twineham. For many years he was a farmer in the Forest community but about 25 years ago moved to Russiaville. He was employed as a salesman for the National Livestock Remedy company.

Surviving are the widow, a foster-daughter, Mrs. George Hamlin of Kokomo and the latter's two children. He leaves also a sister, Mrs. James Scott, Frankfort; a half-sister, Mrs. Julius Barrows, Florida; a brother, Manford, Michigan; and three half-brothers, Harry Snodgrass, Kokomo, Walter of Amboy and Hershel of Colfax.

The body will be removed from the Lowry funeral home in Forest to the residence in Russiaville where friends may call after 11 o'clock Tuesday morning. Funeral services will be held at 2 o'clock Wednesday afternoon at the New London Friends church. Burial will be in the New London cemetery.
