

MRS. LESSIE T. VOGUS

RUSSELLVILLE — Mrs. Lessie T. Vogus, 73, died at the home of her son, Russell Vogus, Russiaville R. R. 2 at 11.30 p. m. Tuesday of a heart ailment. She left her home two months ago to be cared for in the homes of her children.

Born Jan. 8, 1883, in Monroe Township, she was the daughter of Hiram and Martha (Morris) Fritz. On May 5, 1903 she was married to Earl J. Vogus who preceded her in death Feb. 3, 1956.

Their married life was spent on their farm three miles east of Russiaville with the exception of four years when they resided in Russiaville prior to his death.

Other survivors besides the son are a daughter, Mrs. Lee (Edith) Dixon of Kokomo; six grandchildren and two great grandchildren; three brothers, Howard Fritz of Freelow, Carl Fritz of Kokomo and Walter Fritz of Pomona, Calif.; four sisters, Mrs. Alice Floyd of Russiaville; Mrs. Ora Hooper of Indianapolis; Mrs. Lottie Lintley of Kokomo and Mrs. Cleo Sages of Battle Creek, Mich. One son, Dayton, died in 1906.

She was a member of the Russiaville Friends Church and the Howard County Home Demonstration Past Presidents Club.

Funeral services will be at 2:30 p. m. Friday at the Russiaville Friends Church. The body will lie in state at the church one hour before the funeral service. Burial will be in the New London Cemetery.
