

# William Watson Of Howard County Dies in Windfall

Windfall, Ind. May 20—<sup>1941</sup>(Tribune Special)—William Watson, 83, an invalid for more than seven years, died at 6 o'clock Tuesday evening, at the home of his daughter, Mrs. Eunice Lightfoot, near Windfall.

Mr. Watson was the eldest son of John and Elizabeth (Monroe) Watson and spent the greater part of his life in Howard county. Five years of his invalidism he spent with his son Dale, postmaster in Russiaville.

Surviving besides the daughter and son are six grandchildren, and two great grandchildren; a niece, Mrs. Mildred Stunkard, who was reared as a daughter in the Watson home, and two brothers, John Watson of Greentown and Joe Watson of Shelbyville. The wife, Ella (Moon) Watson, died Jan. 11, 1927.

The body was removed to the Edwards funeral home in Windfall and will be returned to the daughter's home Wednesday evening. Funeral services will be held at the New London Friends church but the hour of services has not been decided.
