NEW LONDON (Tribune Area Special)—Charles E. Webb, 85, died at 5:30 p.m. Wednesday at his home here of a heart attack.

Mr. Webb had spent most of a long and useful life in or near New London. He was a devoted member of the New London Friends Church, attending its services to the last.

For many years he was caretaker of the church and cemetery, retiring a few years ago because of frail health.

Surviving are the wife, Ora Twineham Webb; four sons, Walter and Vern of Kokomo, Norval of Richmond and Earl of Berne; 18 grandchildren, 44 great grandchildren and three great, great grandchildren.

He was one of a family of three brothers and one sister, all of whom preceded him in death except the youngest, Willis Webb of Kokomo.

Funeral services will be at the New London Friends Church at 2 p.m. Saturday with interment in the nearby cemetery. The body is at the Stout & Son Funeral Home, Russiaville, where friends may call after 4 p.m. Friday.
